> Session Minutes United Presbyterian Church Clarion, Iowa June 12, 2019

The stated meeting of the Sesion was held Wednesday, June 12, 2019 p.m in the Conference Room. Those in Attendance were: Jeff Fankhauser, Mary Kallem, Malinda Howieson, Karen Wason, Peg Bunn and Rev. Bill Kem, Moderator. Excused: Mark Fisher. Rev. Kem opened with devotions and prayer.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Session voted to approve the Treasurer's Report. It was noted that \$10,000.00 needs to be taken out of the General fund and place in a Pastoral Housing Fund. Rev. Kem and Deb Olson will visit with Bruce Frink about a few minor changes to the Treasure's Report. A report of the Building Fund was given. We exceeded our goal of raising \$10,000.00 from the congregation by \$1000.00. The anonymous donor of \$10,000.00 if we reached our goal has given Rev. Kem that check. We agreed that we need to continue this fund raiser so that we can get our debt below \$100,000.00 dollars by the end of the year. At this time we owe \$124,950.70 before we pay the \$21,000 we have just raised.

CLERK'S REPORT: The Session voted to approve the May 8 Minutes.

We have received the letter of transfer from the Clarion Church of Christ for Pat and Sherri Obrien. We received a thank you from the Clarion Rotary Club for the Backpack donation. We approved the request for use of the church on June 30 by the Polzin family. It was suggested that the names of those serving communion be put in the bulletin and ask Nancy to send them a reminder on the Remind App.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Rev. Kem officiated at funerals for Floyd Keller and Dennis Hamilton, and a wedding in Omaha NB. He had a request from Heinz Schmid that his 3 grandchildren have asked to be baptized. The Session voted to approve that Ally, Wren and Nicholas will be baptized on either July 14 or 28. Heinz Schmid also requested that Bill would do a vow renewal for his daughter-in-laws sister and her husband.

PW: Mary Kallem reported that the fund raising meal for Festival In The Park went well. The board is going to discuss changing how much of the camp expense they pay for the kids going to camp.

CHRISTIAN ED TEAM: It is planned that new material from Cokesbury Publishing will be used starting this fall. It is a 3 yr plan and that the pastors will use the same scripture in their sermons as is being taught in Sunday School.

LENTEN TEAM: The One Great Hour of Sharing Offering was overlooked during Lent, so we will have a time to collect this the end of July or first of August.

MISSION TEAM: They are talking about going to Marshalltown to help rebuilding from the tornado.

ORDINARY TEAM: They have discussed going to an Iowa Cubs game.

PROPERTY TEAM: The arm on one of the front doors is broken. Ted Bunn is getting repairs.

WORSHIP TEAM: Ted Bunn requests approx. \$250.00 to upgrade software in the sanctuary. It was M/S/A to allow this.

SESSION ASSIGNMENTS: Rev. Kem and Deb: visit with Bruce Frink about Treasurer's Report. Rev. Kem: talk to Nancy about putting in the bulletin and sending a reminder to those serving communion. Rev. Kem closed the meeting with prayer at 8:00.

They meet the 2nd Wednesday of every month except July.
