# Fruit Tart

Indulge in a timeless fruit tart boasting a buttery shortbread crust, a luscious vanilla custard, and an abundance of fresh fruit!

#### - Ingredients -

#### **Sweet Tart Dough**

½ cup unsalted butter (room temperature)

1/3 cup sugar

1 1/4 cup all-purpose flour

1 egg yolk

1/4 teaspoon salt Nonstick cooking spray

#### Filling/Toppings

2 cups whole milk

½ cup sugar

1 large egg

2 large egg volks

3 tablespoons cornstarch

2 teaspoons vanilla extract

4 cups fresh mixed berries

1 sliced kiwi and mango





#### - Directions -

#### **Sweet Tart Dough**

1) Using a stand mixer with a paddle attachment, beat the butter, sugar, and salt until creamy. Scrape the bowl's sides, add flour, and mix until incorporated. The mixture will resemble wet, clumpy sand. Add the egg volk and mix until evenly combined and the dough clumps together. Knead the dough lightly in the bowl, then shape it into a 6-inch disk, wrap tightly in plastic, and refrigerate for at least 30 minutes (or up to 5 days).

2) Lightly coat a 9.5-inch tart pan with a removable bottom or a 9-inch pie shell with cooking spray and flour. Place the chilled dough in the pan.

Press pieces of dough against the sides to make them about 1/8-inch thick and slightly above the rim (trim later). Use your hand to evenly press the remaining dough into the pan's bottom. Ensure there are no seams and press firmly at the corners. Trim the dough's top edge with a paring knife to align with the pan's rim. Cover with plastic wrap and freeze for at least 30 minutes to chill.

3) Preheat oven to 230 degrees Fahrenheit and position rack in the middle of oven

4) Place chilled tart shell dough on baking sheet and back for 25 minutes or until golden brown. Let cool to room temperature on a wire rack.



#### Filling/Toppings

1) Heat the milk in a medium pot until it boils. Remove from heat. In a heat-proof mixing bowl, whisk together sugar, egg, egg yolks, and cornstarch until smooth and lightened (about 2 minutes). Gradually whisk a guarter of the hot milk into the egg mixture (tempering). Pour the tempered mixture back into the pot with the remaining milk and whisk

to combine. Return the pot to medium heat and cook, whisking constantly, until the pastry cream thickens (about 2 minutes). Stir in butter and vanilla and cook for an additional minute. The cream should have a thick consistency. Transfer the cream to a shallow bowl, cover with

plastic wrap pressed directly onto the surface, and chill for a few hours until cold (or up to 2 days).

2) Transfer the tart shell to a serving platter and remove the tart ring. Whisk the chilled pastry cream until smooth and spread it evenly in the shell using an offset spatula. Arrange fruit generously in your desired design on top of the cream. Heat the apricot jam with 1 tablespoon of water in a small saucepan over medium heat. whisking, until thin. Strain the jam if necessary, then lightly brush the fruit with a thin layer of apricot glaze using a pastry brush. Chill until ready to serve!
