VIVIENNE L. PENICK AWARD NOMINATION

Mrs. Vivienne L. Penick was the First Lady of Peoples Institutional Baptist Church in Seattle and the second president of the North Pacific Baptist Convention Women's Auxiliary from 1948 until 1950. Mrs. Penick was a strong and compassionate leader of the Convention women and highly active in her home church and community. She was given the prestigious honor of President Emeritus of the Women's Auxiliary. This award was created in honor of her dedication to Kingdom-building work and to recognize the efforts of deserving women within the convention.

The Award Committee requests nominations for women in our congregations that are diligent workers and in good standing within their church. The Vivienne L. Penick Award will be presented at the NPBC Past Presidents Luncheon in July.
