This comprehensive, day-long session is designed for animal welfare professionals who are involved in disaster preparedness and response. Led by experts from the Emergency Programs Division of NCDA&CS, the class will cover essential aspects of animal care during emergencies, from pre-disaster planning to post-disaster recovery.

Participants will learn how to develop and implement emergency response plans, coordinate animal rescue efforts, manage resources, and ensure the safety of both animals and responders during crises. Topics will include understanding the roles of different agencies in disaster scenarios, best practices for evacuation, sheltering, and care, and how to handle the unique challenges of working with animals in high-stress environments.

By the end of the day, participants will have a clearer understanding of their role in disaster response, stronger collaborative strategies with partner agencies, and a greater capacity to protect animals during emergencies.
