The return of warmer weather, coupled with recent rainfall, provides unfortunately favorable conditions for mosquitoes.

Champion Township will perform Mosquito Spraying on the following dates;

June 7th & 8th July 5th & 6th

Roadside spraying of adult mosquitoes is of limited effectiveness. A comprehensive plan to reduce the mosquito population should also include larviciding.

The Trumbull County Combined Health Department will be providing, at no cost, Mosquito Larviciding Service, which are tablets that are dropped into stagnant water to inhibit mosquito breeding.

Larviciding is NOT meant to take the place of any action to control adult mosquitos or replace personal protection efforts (i.e. use of repellents, wearing light colored clothing, long pants, long sleeve shirts etc.)

If you have areas on your property that you would like treated contact The **Trumbull County Combined Health Department at (330) 675-2489**. They also can answer any questions you may have concerning their services and recommendations related to mosquito control.

Residents should also take measures, on their own property, to eliminate any stagnant water if possible. Stagnant water areas provide ideal breeding areas for mosquitoes.

Hopefully these combined efforts will reduce the mosquito population and help to control associated health risks connected with mosquito bites.
