Champion Township Clean-up Day-2020

Champion Township Trustees and Community Groups, in an effort to keep the Township attractive and free of debris, and provide residents with a means to dispose of household waste and used tires have designated Saturday April 25, 2020 as Township Cleanup Day.

Volunteers and members of Community Organizations will target roadsides and remove litter that has accumulated along them. Please be vigilant of these volunteers as they work on and along the roadside.

Champion Township will accept used tires (on and off the rims) at the Township yard adjacent to the Cemetery between the hours of 9am and 3 pm on April 25th. Disposal of 8 tires per resident is permitted excluding large truck tires and rims which are not permitted. Disposal of these tires is funded through a Grant provided by the Geauga-Trumbull Solid Waste District

Household waste such as yard debris, unusable appliances, old furniture, used clothing etc. can be dropped off also between the hours of 9am to 1pm April 25th at the Township Yard. Dumpsters provided by the Township will be available with personnel to assist you. We cannot accept hazardous waste such as chemicals, paint, antifreeze etc. We also cannot accommodate large quantities of construction debris such as concrete blocks and large quantities of shingles.
