The Arts - Conducting art programs and competitions to assist children to develop a love of the arts via dance, poetry and writing events;

National Trends and Services - Helping homeless families via Bethany House; providing food, clothing, and gifts to needy families throughout the year and during the holidays; providing assistance for women to reenter the workforce via "Dress for Success;"

International Trends & Services - Providing education on foreign affairs, international business and social issues via the GEAR UP Program and the United Nations; and

Health & Human Services - Supporting breast cancer awareness; overseeing oral health education via the Colgate Dental Van providing over 2,000 dental exams to underserved Long Island school children;

In addition, every year the Long Island Links award college scholarships to students in need throughout Long Island. These students attend top ranked universities and colleges throughout the United States including Ivy League schools and Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs).
