How to Add and Subtract Decimals

See if you can line the decimals up on top of each other first and then add or subtract.

OR... ignore the decimals and then make a "wall" at the end. See how many swoops it takes to touch the wall, and add them into your answer!

How to Divide Decimals

Option 1: Use fractions and simplify. (0.56 would become 56/100 and 0.04 would become 4/100).

Option 2: Make the decimals whole numbers. This is the same as Option 2 for when you multiply decimals... but you divide once you have the whole numbers!

How to Multiply Decimals

OPTION 1: Convert the decimals into fractions (0.4 x 0.9 would become: 4/10 and 9/10).

OPTION 2: Convert the decimals into whole numbers by moving your decimals. Multiply your whole numbers. Then move your decimals back.

What are Operations?

Adding +
Subtracting -

Multiplying x
Dividing ÷
