PROGRAM ADS & SPONSORSHIPS

 - Pack loosely (no individual wrapping), separate with wax/parchment paper if needed.
 - Throw-away containers preferred; label any container you want returned.
 - Clearly indicate type, gluten-free/vegan, or if refrigeration is needed.

CONCERT ATTIRE

- **All Performers:** Please avoid strong scents to respect those with allergies or asthma.
- **Women:** Black pants with a white or black top, or a black dress. Avoid anything too sparkly.
- **Men:** Black pants, long-sleeve white or black dress shirt, and a dark-colored tie. Suit jackets optional.

CONCERT REMINDERS

- **Belongings:** Bring coats, purses, and personal items to the church office (Chapel behind the Sanctuary). Coat rack available. Office locked during concert.
- **Folders:** Leave on chairs after final rehearsals.
- **On Stage:** Only water allowed. Keep tissues and cough drops in folders or pockets.
