

### WHAT IS AHPS — AND WHAT DOES IT HAVE TO DO WITH CALVARY?

Over 30 years ago, Calvary Church was on the verge of closing. The roof and windows leaked, the Sanctuary was shut down because there was no money to heat it, and there was no pastor in place. Things looked dire.

At that time, the Rev. Bob Richards, Director of Church Union (whose office was where our pastor's office is now), stepped in to serve as Calvary's "volunteer" minister. At the same time, concerned neighbors and friends formed the Allegheny Historic Preservation Society (AHPS) – a nonprofit organization with one purpose: to secure grant and foundation funding to save Calvary's historic building.

Their efforts were extraordinary. Over three million dollars has since been raised to restore and upgrade our building: the slate roof was repaired, the Tiffany windows were restored, an elevator was installed, carpeting was replaced, the Sanctuary was reopened, and the organ was restored. Within just  $2\frac{1}{2}$  years, Calvary had a full-time pastor again. The list of improvements continues to grow – because when there are resources, much can be done!

We have inherited a treasure: our church. And the work isn't finished. With new projects like upgrading our bathrooms, AHPS continues to play a vital role in keeping Calvary beautiful, safe, and accessible.

Following the screening, we'll dive into UnClobber by Colby Martin. This thought-provoking study reexamines the six so-called "Clobber Passages" often used to exclude LGBTQIA+ people, revealing what Scripture truly says—and doesn't say—about homosexuality. Through open conversation, biblical exploration, and Martin's personal journey, we'll move from bad theology toward deeper faith, compassion, and welcome for all God's children. All are welcome!


