At Padgate Academy we are determined that every student should succeed in achieving the qualifications that will enable them to go onto future success.

The current year 11 cohort has had a very difficult time having to navigate their studies through lockdown, illness and/or periods of self-isolation. We appreciate that they are in a difficult position however we cannot allow this to be an excuse. The one thing that we can be certain of during these uncertain times is that at the end of this academic year GCSE grades will be awarded that will influence our students' futures. To help tackle this we will be holding Directed Study sessions after school on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday which will last between ½ hour to an hour. We are also putting a lot of measures into place to support students:

1. **Study materials** have been bought for students in most subjects. Please ensure that they use them.
2. **Study zones:** Students will be able to use the library after school on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday if they want a place to study quietly. We are also going to offer a weekend study zone - details to follow.
3. **Tuition sessions** for targeted students will begin soon. Students will be identified based on their mini-mock performance and areas for improvement.
4. **Mentoring for targeted students** who need extra support to help them organise their time.
5. **Rewards** will be given to students who are working well to encourage them to continue with their great efforts.

Mock Examinations will take place from **30th November to 11th December**. Examination timetables will be issued shortly.
