Dear Parents and Carers

Year 11 Mock Examinations: 7th March – 17th March 2022

Further to my letter regarding arrangements for the Year 11 mock examinations, please find a copy of the examination timetable below. Students should attend school at the usual time and make sure that they are lined up and ready for their morning examination at 8.50am. Afternoon examinations will start at 1.05pm and will be finished in plenty of time for the end of school at 3.05pm.

If students are not in an examination, teachers will be teaching as normal. With this in mind, we will expect students to continue to bring their books and equipment to all lessons as usual.

I would also like to remind you that mobile phones and smart watches are forbidden in any examination room. If students bring any of these devices into school they will be told to leave them in their bags which will be kept in a locked room. If a student is found to have a smart watch or phone on their person during the examination (even if it is turned off) there will be serious consequences and this will have to be reported to the examination board.

It is pleasing to see so many students engaging with our intervention sessions at lunchtimes and after school. If your child is struggling with their revision, we have included a comprehensive list of the topics that will be assessed as well as revision materials and websites that the students can access to support them at the end of this letter.

I would also like to take this opportunity to remind you of our Saturday Study Zone which is open from 10.00am-12.00noon every Saturday in the school canteen. This is a fully staffed, safe and warm environment where hot drinks and food are provided. We also have tutors in English and maths that students can have access to. Students can arrive at any time and stay for the whole session or just part of the session. They do not have to wear school uniform.
