



## What the students are learning in

<b>English</b>	<p><b>Group 1 (7,8)</b> - In English, students will be exploring the theme of conflict through a range of texts. This includes several poems and extracts from various novels. <b>Maths</b>	<p><b>Group 1 (7,8)</b> - In Mathematics, students will begin by exploring number and the properties of number. This includes number place value, reading and writing numbers, ordering numbers, odd and even numbers and number sequences.</p> <p><b>Group 2 (9, 10, 11)</b> – Students will begin by exploring number and the properties of number. This includes number place value, reading and writing numbers, ordering numbers, odd and even numbers and number sequences, negative numbers, significant figures, and decimal places.</p>
<b>Science</b>	In science, students will learn all about digestion and nutrition
<b>Computer Science</b>	In Computer Science, students will learn how to use technology safely, respectfully and responsibly; recognise acceptable/unacceptable behaviour; identify a range of ways to report concerns about content and how to stay safe online
<b>History</b>	<p><b>Group 1 (7,8)</b> - Students will be learning all about Tudor times</p> <p><b>Group 2 (9, 10, 11)</b> – Students will be learning about a historical change over time – medicine through the ages</p>
<b>Religious Studies</b>	<p><b>Group 1 (7,8)</b> - Students will consider what Hinduism</p> <p><b>Group 2 (9, 10, 11)</b> – Students will study moral issues including capital punishment and abortion,</p>
<b>Geography</b>	<p><b>Group 1 (7,8)</b> - Students will be learning all about climate in Asia</p> <p><b>Group 2 (9, 10, 11)</b> – Students will study changes in tourism trends</p>
<b>Life skills/ ASDAN</b>	Students will be learning about important healthy choices and living a healthy lifestyle.
<b>Food Technology</b>	Students will begin learning about food from around the world and within different cultures.
<b>Art</b>	In art, students will be learning about the 7 formal elements of art
<b>Drama</b>	Workshop based activities to develop speaking, listening, communication and social skills. Students will also be introduced to some key drama skills including freeze frames and thought tracks.
