Mock Exam

You will be given a selection of themes to work on and a designated time scale to produce a piece of work. You will need to be organised and committed to working outside of the lesson.

Art visits

A04 Present

Present a personal and meaningful response, showing your creative journey throughout.

A03 Record

Refine work by exploring ideas, techniques, processes media and materials.

A01 Develop

Developing ideas through investigations including a range of artists, designers and themes.



Coursework
