How should Padgate Academy students study from home?

Should the school close, or if your child is unable to attend school due to Government self-isolation guidance, it is important that they are purposeful at home and continue their studies.

We have made all learning resources available through our school website. Students should follow their daily timetable to allocate blocks of time to each subject. This will ensure they spend enough time on each subject. All students will be provided with a blank exercise book to write in. Maths work will all be completed online on MathsWatch or Method Maths.

We already have in use the following online services: Student Hub, Seneca, MathsWatch, and Kerboodle. Students should continue using these services, please ensure your child is able to log in by visiting our website (www.padgateacademy.co.uk) and clicking on Students > Online Services.

Student Hub Access, Email and Office 365 (Guide enclosed)

- Students should access the 'Student Hub, Email and Office 365' with their school email address and computer password.
- Student usernames all follow the same format: the year they started, then, first three letters of their first name, then the first three letters of their surname, i.e. John Smith, currently in year 11, would be 15johsmi@padgateacademy.co.uk
