Dear Parent/Carer

As we approach the final weeks for our Year 11 students in school, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support of Padgate Academy over the past five years. May Examinations

The May examinations will begin on Friday 14th May and will continue until Friday 21st May. These examinations will provide evidence for the Teacher Assessed Grades with full JCQ exam conditions implemented. Students will be expected to be in school from 8.40am - 3.05pm each day in full school uniform. Access arrangements will be in place for those students who need them. Students will be expected to bring in revision material so that they can revise during periods when they are not in examinations.

Leaving date

The official leaving date for year 11 students will be Friday 28th May 2021. Students will come into school at 9.30am as usual to attend a final leavers' assembly where they will have the opportunity to sign shirts and say goodbye to their friends. They will be dismissed at 1.05pm. *Please note: students must attend the morning session if they wish to come to the leavers' assembly.*

Year 11 party

Due to the current restrictions, we will be unable to have a formal year 11 prom as in previous years. Will still wish to give the students an opportunity to celebrate the end of school so we will be having an informal year 11 party on Friday 11th June from 1pm – 3pm. Teacher Assessed Grades

As mentioned previously, the 2021 GCSE grades will be a Teacher Assessed Grade (TAG). This is a grade that is awarded from a broad evidence base. The sources of evidence which have been used to formulate this grade has been clearly explained to the students by each individual subject teacher. This process is also the same for BTEC subjects.
