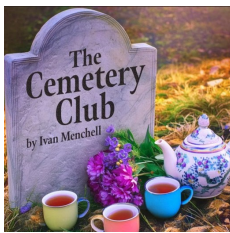
The Diary of Anne Frank by Frances Goodrich & Albert Hackett, adapted by Wendy Kessleman
