Introduction to Evangelism Training

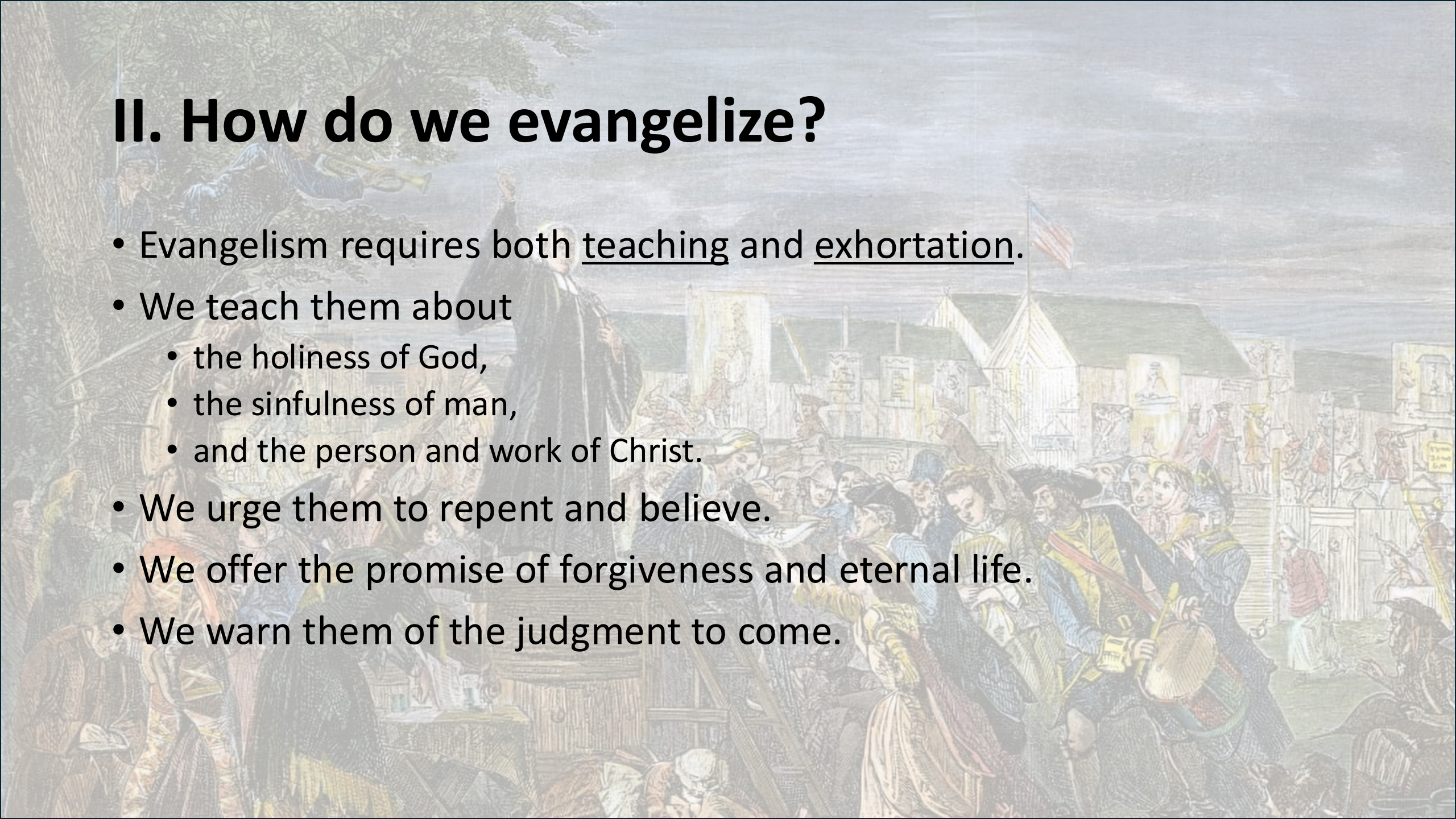
- The primary goal of this class is to equip you to become a more effective evangelist where God has already placed you.
- Teaching: You will gain a biblical understanding of evangelism through classroom instruction, Scripture memorization, and theological reading.
- Training: You will have opportunities to practice articulating the gospel in your own words.
- Class Project: Pray daily for three unbelievers in your life and evangelize at least one of them.

I. What is Evangelism?

- The proclamation of good news (1 Thess 3:6).
- **Jesus evangelized.** “I must proclaim the good news of the kingdom of God to the other cities also, for I was sent for this purpose” (Luke 4:43).
- **The apostles evangelized.** “And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they did not cease teaching and proclaiming the good news that Jesus is the Christ” (Acts 5:42).
- **Christians evangelized.** “Therefore, those who had been scattered went about, proclaiming the good news of the word” (Acts 8:4).

II. How do we evangelize?

- Evangelism requires both teaching and exhortation.
- We teach them about
 - the holiness of God,
 - the sinfulness of man,
 - and the person and work of Christ.
- We urge them to repent and believe.
- We offer the promise of forgiveness and eternal life.
- We warn them of the judgment to come.



III. Why do we evangelize?

- Our sense of duty (Matt 28:19–20).
- Our compassion for sinners (Matt 9:36).
- Our desire to glorify God (1 Cor 10:31).
