Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Tanglewood Forest Limited District will hold a regular meeting on **Wednesday, July 17, 2019**, at **6:00 p.m.**, at the Tanglewood Pool House, 9809 Curlew Drive, Austin, Texas, for the following purposes:

CITIZEN COMMUNICATIONS

1. Receive citizen communications; *[Members of the public may sign up to speak for three (3) minutes regarding general topics or specific agenda items. If speaking on specific agenda items, citizens may speak one time per agenda topic. Those desiring to speak must complete the citizen communication form supplied by the District so they may be recognized by the Board President. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda.]*

2. Consider approval of the June 19, 2019, regular meeting minutes;

PARK/RECREATION FACILITIES

3. Receive General Management report, including, but not limited to, restrictive covenant enforcement, and the use, maintenance, repair and improvement of District facilities and District parks and take any related action;
4. Review pool operations report and consider any action regarding pool operator and pool maintenance/lifeguard contract, leak repairs, maintenance, general repairs and upkeep, schedule, funding, lifeguards, and rates and fees for pool;
5. Receive landscape maintenance report and consider any action regarding landscape maintenance contract, proposals, estimates for additional work, maintenance, repairs and improvements, irrigation, and tree trimming;
6. Receive reports on park and restroom cleaning and services from cleaning contractor and on pond cleaning and services from Aquatic Features and take any related action on the services or contracts for those services;

7. Discuss and consider repair, maintenance, inspection, and improvements of District property, including, but not limited to, parks, playscapes, tennis courts, pond, restrooms, electrical systems, lighting, and parking areas;

ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

8. Discuss and consider FY2019 budget amendments, if any;
9. Discuss and consider approval of payment of bills, per diems, and invoices relating to operational and maintenance or repair expenses;
10. Review and approve quarterly investment report for 2nd quarter;
11. Discuss and consider general management services and contract renewal;
12. Discuss and consider adoption of the tax and budget planning calendar for 2019, and take any related action;
13. Discuss and consider additional pool rules and/or adjustments to the pool rules;
14. Discuss and consider communication, press, and social media release protocol;
15. Discuss and consider public safety within the District, including homeless encampments on or near District property;
16. Discuss and consider the Community Activated Park Project and form for a new trail head;
17. Receive restrictive covenants report and consider any action regarding restrictive covenant enforcement, land use compliance, proposed land use and litigation matters, including District's process for legal action and legal action on covenant enforcement;
18. Discuss and consider committee structure, responsibilities, and community involvement in District Committees;
19. Discuss and consider action on Deed Restriction Committee's proposal for citizen notification;
20. Receive General Counsel report, including, but not limited to, pending contract issues, open records requests, litigation matters, and other legal issues, if any;
21. Receive committee reports from Directors; and
22. Discuss and consider time, date, and agenda items for the next Board meeting.

The Board of Directors is authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act to convene in closed or executive session for certain purposes. These purposes include receiving legal advice from its attorney pursuant to §551.071 of the Texas Government Code; discussing real property matters pursuant to §551.072 of the Texas Government Code; discussing gifts and donations pursuant to §551.073 of the Texas Government Code; discussing personnel matters pursuant to §551.074 of the Texas Government Code; discussing security personnel or devices pursuant to §551.076 of the Texas Government Code. If the Board determines to enter executive session regarding any item on this agenda, the Presiding Officer will announce that an executive session will be held and will identify the item to be discussed and provision from the Open Meetings Act that authorizes the closed or executive session.
