Individual members of the public wishing to address the Board at this meeting must register to speak in the 15-minute period before the meeting begins by signing up on the attendance form.

PUBLIC COMMENT

1. Receive communications from the public on items not listed on the posted agenda; *[Members of the public may sign up to speak for three (3) minutes regarding general topics. Members of the public may collectively address the Board for a total of 15 minutes on items not on the current agenda under public comment. Those desiring to speak must complete the citizen communication form supplied by the District so they may be recognized by the Board President. In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda. No formal action, discussion, deliberation, or comment will be made for items not on this agenda.]*
2. Public Comment on Agenda Items; *[Members of the public may comment on any agenda item listed below. Members of the public may speak for up to two minutes per agenda item on which they comment. Members of the public will speak on an agenda item after the item is called by the presiding officer, but before Board consideration of the item. Individuals may address the Board once per item. Those desiring to speak must complete the citizen communication form supplied by the District so they may be recognized by the Board President.]*
