Winter Plant Show Rules and Plant Categories

THE SOCIETY ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE PROPERTY OF EXHIBITORS IN ALL CASES THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES SHALL BE CONSIDERED FINAL.

- Any exhibit not in accordance with classes listed under Show rule n.10 must be disqualified and marked N.A. by the Judges.
- 2. All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor and shall have been in the possession of the exhibitor for at least twelve (12) months prior to this Show.
- 3. Exhibitors are required to communicate the number of entries they intend to exhibit no later than 48 hours before show starts.
- 4. All exhibits must be displayed before judging has commenced.
- 5. Exhibits must not be removed before the end of the show, unless with permission of the Show Committee.
- 6. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- 7. EXHIBITORS IN ALL CLASSES ARE REQUESTED TO NAME EXHIBITS ON A LABEL, EITHER INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE POT. SUCH LABEL MUST BE VISIBLE TO THE JUDGE.
- 8. All exhibits/containers must not exceed 40cm in width.
- 9. To assign a winner, each class must have a minimum of 3 entries.

- 2. Cyclamen foliage
- 3. Primula in flower
- 4. Primulaceae in flower (excluding. Primula and Cyclamen)
- 5. Ranunculaceae
- 6. Iris
- 7. South African geophyte
- 8. Crocus
- 9. Iridaceae (excluding Iris, South African geophyte, Crocus)
- 10. Narcissus (not exceeding 200mm height)
- 11. Amaryllidaceae (excluding Narcissus and South African geophyte)
- 12. Flowering Papaveraceae
- 13. Flowering Orchidaceae
- 14. Flowering Shrub
- 15. Shrub (foliage)
- 16. Flowering Cushion plant
- 17. Cushion plant(foliage)
- 18. Flowering Rock garden plant grown from seed
- 19. Flowering rock garden plant not previously specified
- 20. Flowering Bulbous, Cormous or tuberous plant not previously specified
