





Construction season: Beware the sun

Construction season is beginning to ramp up as the northern states exit the winter months.

The warmest months that makeup our summer are right around the corner. Temperatures across the U.S. are known to reach well above 90 degrees Fahrenheit with a protentional to go above 100 degrees. With these high temperatures, workers face an increased risk of experiencing heat exhaustion and heat stroke, collectively known as heat-related illnesses.

It's important to understand the difference between heat exhaustion and heat stroke - the terms are often confused with each other.

Heat exhaustion is defined as the body's response to an excessive loss of water and salt, usually through sweating.

Heat stroke is a condition that occurs when the body becomes unable to control its temperature and can cause death or permanent disability.

As temperatures begin to rise, employers should know the signs of heat-related illness to help employees stay safe. Here's a snapshot of common symptoms.

Symptoms of heat-related illnesses

Heat Exhaustion

- * Rapid heartbeat
- * Heavy sweating
- * Extreme weakness or fatigue
- * Dizziness
- * Nausea, vomiting
- * Irritability
- * Fast, shallow breathing
- * Slightly elevated body temperature

Heat Stroke

- * High body temperature
- * Confusion
- * Loss of coordination
- * Hot, dry skin or profuse sweating
- * Throbbing headache
- * Seizures, coma

Construction workers can take steps to limit exposure to heat-related illnesses by:


- * Monitoring your physical condition (and that of your coworkers) for signs or symptoms of a heat illness.
- * Wearing light-colored, loose-fitting, breathable clothing such as cotton Avoid non-breathable synthetic clothing
- * Gradually building up to heavy work
- * Scheduling heavy work during the coolest part of the day
- * Taking more breaks when doing heavier work, and in high heat and humidity Take breaks in the shade or a cool area
- * Drinking water frequently Drink enough water that you never become thirsty
- * Being aware that protective clotting or personal protective equipment may increase the risk of heat-related illnesses

Supervisors should continually monitor conditions on their jobsites and ensure workers are doing all they can to avoid a heat-related illness. It is crucial to make sure breaks are taken and plenty of water is available for employees to stay hydrated. If heatrelated illness symptoms are identified take necessary steps to provide first aid. If heat stroke symptoms are noticed request immediate medical assistance: move the worker to a cool, shaded area; remove excess clothing and apply cool water to their body. If a worker is experiencing heat exhaustion encourage that person rest in a cool area, drink plenty of water or other cool beverages, and take a cool shower, bath or sponge bath.
