Individual- \$25 Family-\$35

All members in good standing will be eligible for year-end awards. In order to be a member in good standing you must meet the following criteria:

Meetings:

o Attend **2** general membership meetings a year in person. (not special events or holidays)
o Attend 4 virtual meetings

Volunteer Hour Requirements:
o 6 hours for an individual membership

o 10 hours for a family membership

o For hours to be valid, volunteers working at the shows must be over 16.

Sponsorship:

Each member (individual or family) must bring in 1 sponsorship.
Sponsorships are \$125 per class or \$475 per division.
Can be a business, family or group.
Sponsorships must be turned in by the June show to allow points accrued before then to count toward year end awards.

Show Attendance:

o Must show at the majority of the shows (or 50%) in the same horse-rider combination.

2025 Show Updates

No Gate fee for 2025!

- No Gate ree for 2025!
 Administrative fee \$15 for members, \$20 for non-members.
 Staggered class fees-all session 1, all equitation/pattern classes, and water glass classes are \$13 for members and \$18 for non members.
 Each over fences division has its own dedicated flat equitation class.
 English halter and western halter have been renamed- "Non Stock and Stock". Horses may NOT cross enter.
- Changed the "beginner adult category" to "amatuer". Added a "novice" category.
- Added equitation classes specific to English type riders, and western riders.
- Changed the age requirements for some classes so that juveniles and adults do not have to show in the same class.
- Added a juvenile ranch walk/jog class.
- Edited some of our category descriptions:
 - Pre-Beginner: Can not go in any classes that ask for a canter. (geared for *vounger children*)
 - Beginner: 2 years or less showing, can not show novice & beginner
 - **Novice:** 2-4 years showing, can **not** show pre-beginner or beginner
 - Juvenile: 17 and under Adult: age 18+ (no exceptions)
 - Amatuer: any non professional rider
 - Open: open for any age, and appropriate skill level. professionals included.
- A show guideline is being worked on and will be published very soon. It will include general club rules, a description of each class, and the standard that judges are being asked to follow this year for each class.
