Requirements for Class

1	Lead Line Open - 13 yrs. & Under	Led by one or more Adults (17 yrs. & Older)
2	English Halter	Halter Only - No Bridles - English Type Horses
3	Western Halter	Halter Only - No Bridles - Stock Type Horses
4	Spotted Horse Racking (No Pads)	Walk, Pleasure Rack, Back in Line Up (Must have spots)
5	Show Pleasure Racking - (Padded or Flat Shod)	Walk, Show Pleasure Rack, Back in lineup, Good Headset, No false tails
6	Double Dollar Bareback	Bareback with a dollar under each leg - Jackpot to the winner
7	Adult Walk/Trot English - Any Breed - (18 yrs. & Over)	Walk, Trot - English Tack
8	Adult Gaited Trail Horse Class - (Barefoot/Keg) 18 yrs & Over	Four Beat Gait, No Headset, Minimum Control, Halt, and Back
9	Juvenile Showmanship - (17 yrs. & Under)	Walk/Trot or Rack -Rider is judged on appearance, presentation, ability
10	Novice Western Rider - 4 yrs. Or Less Showing for rider	Walk, Jog or Rack - Beginner Riders Only
11	Trail Pleasure Racking - (Flat Shod or Barefoot)	Back in lineup, True easy gait, Halt, Minimum rein control
12	Adult Showmanship (18yrs. & Over)	Walk/Trot or Rack -Rider is judged on appearance, presentation,ability
13	Juvenile Western Pleasure - (17 yrs. & Under)	Walk, Jog & Lope, Back in lineup
14	Oldies, but Goodies Class	Walk/Trot or Rack - Must be 50 years or older
15	Stick Horse Class - All Receive A Blue Ribbon	Open to 12 yrs. & under - all first place winners

16	Juvenile Gaited Trail Horse Class - Barefoot or Keg (17 yrs.&Under)	Four Beat Gait, No Headset, Minimum Control, Halt, and Back
17	Walkingbred - (Padded or Flat Shod)	Walk, Rack, Rack On - Good headset
18	Juvenile Walk/Trot - English - Any Breed - (17 yrs. & Under)	Walk, Trot - 17 yrs. & Under
19	Style Racking - (Padded or Flat Shod)	Walk, Style Rack - Not judged on speed
20	Country Pleasure Racking - (Flat Shod)	Single rein, Minimum rein control, Back in lineup
21	Novice English Rider - 4 yrs. or Less Showing for Rider	Walk, Trot or Rack - Beginners Riders only
22	Water Glass Class	Cup of Water - Most water left in cup wins
23	Western Walk/Jog	Walk, Jog, Back in lineup
24	Open Racking - (Padded or Flat Shod)	Walk, Rack, Rack On - Good headset - Any breed horse
25	Adult Western Pleasure (18 yrs. & Over)	Walk, Jog & Lope - Back in lineup
26	Flat Shod Racking - Any Breed	Walk, Rack, Rack On
27	Juvenile Racking (Padded or Flat Shod) - (17 yrs. & Under)	Walk, Pleasure Rack (17 yrs & Under)
28	Country Pleasure Style Racking - (Flat Shod)	Walk, Style Rack, Back in lineup - Good Headset - Knee action ok

Entry Fees: Ribbons for top 5 places (unless otherwise noted below)

Gate Entry: \$5.00/Person (Children under 12 get in free)

Stick Horse Class: No Charge - Limited horses available to use

Regular Classes: \$5.00/Members per class,
\$10.00/Non-members per class

Bareback Class: \$2.00 provided by rider to be used in event
No Ribbons, Winner takes all

Classes of 12 or more entries will be split in two and then brought back in for a final workout

Adult: 18 years of age and older / Juvenile: 17 years of age and younger

*****Negative Coggins - Required by Georgia Law***** (Be Prepared to show it when you register)

Western or English Tack - Casual Dress / Western Pleasure Classes are to reverse to the inside

Registration opens 2 hour prior to the start of the show

Registration for the first 4 classes closes 20 minutes prior the start of the show

You must wear the back number assigned at Registration in each class. Do NOT change numbers. Contact Registration, if a change is necessary.

Concession Stand opens for business one hour prior to the start of the show. Remember to bring a dessert to be sold at the concession stand.

MIDWAY SADDLE CLUB GENERAL RULES

- The Judge's decision is final.
- No Person under the age of 18 will be allowed to show a stallion in any Class.
- No boot, false tails, crops or full bridles (4 rein bridles) are allowed in any Country Pleasure, Trail Classes
- No boots, false tails or switches are allowed in Show Pleasure Classes, however you may ride with a crop and full bridle (4 rein bridle) if desired.
- No chains, leather rings, knocker boots or other action devices are allowed in any classes. Bell boots and heel boots are allowed in Performance Classes.
- To receive a refund, your horse must be scratched at least 2 classes prior to the class from which the horse is being removed.
- Membership renewal dues must be paid on or before March 1st.
- No cursing or other loud or abusive behavior is allowed. No alcoholic beverages are allowed. No Dogs or other animals are allowed on premises.
- The removal of a horse from any Class is the responsibility of the Ringmaster. Any horse deemed out of control will be dismissed.

The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel any class. Midway Saddle Club will not be held responsible for any accident or injury.

Under Georgia Law an Equine Activity or Professional is not liable for any injury to or the death of any participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks or equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12, Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia annotated. HB No. 292.
