Classes:	Description of Classes:	
1	Lead Line Open - 12 yrs and under	Led by one or more adults.
2	English Halter	Halter Only. No Bridles.
3	Western Halter	Halter Only. No Bridles.
4	Spotted Horse Racking- No pads	Walk, <b>Pleasure Rack</b> , Back in line Up. Must have spots.
5	*Beginner Walk/ Trot/ Canter Equitation	Walk, Trot, Canter. Any discipline. Judged on rider's ability.
6	*Beginner Walk/ Trot/ Canter Showmanship	Walk, Trot, Canter. Any discipline. Judged on rider & ring presence.
7	Double Dollar Bareback	Bareback with a dollar under each leg - Jackpot to the winner.
8	Style Racking - Padded or Flat Shod	Walk, <b>Style Rack</b> - Not judged on speed.
9	Juvenile Western Rider	Walk, Jog or Rack. Western Tack.
10	*Beginner Walk/Trot Equitation	Walk, Trot. Any discipline. Judged on rider's ability.
11	*Beginner Walk/Trot Showmanship	Walk, Trot. Any discipline. Judged on rider & ring presence.
12	Trail Pleasure Racking - Flat Shod or Barefoot	Walk, True easy 4 beat <b>rack</b> . Back-up in line up.
13	Open Racking- Padded or Flatshod	Walk, <b>Rack</b> , Rack On. Any breed horse racking horse.
14	Juvenile Western Pleasure	Walk, Jog & Lope, Back in lineup.
15	Oldies but Goodies	Walk, Trot/Rack- Must be 50 years or older.
16	Water Glass Class	Cup of Water - Most water left in cup wins.
17	Beginner Racking Flatshod- 12 yrs. and under	Walk, <b>Rack</b> . Any discipline. Attendants in center ring ok.
18	Stick Horse Class	Free! Open to everyone.

19	Buy a Class	\$30- Make your own class of any kind.
20	Racking Non- Saddlebred- Padded or Flat Shod	Walk, <b>Rack</b> , Rack on.
21	Country Pleasure Style Racking- Flat Shod	Walk, <b>Style Rack</b> . Back in line up. Knee action ok.
22	Juvenile Racking- Padded or Flat Shod	Walk, <b>Rack</b> . No rack on.
23	* Beginner Walk/ Trot on a lead Equitation	Walk, Trot. Lead by an attendant. Judged on rider's ability.
24	* Beginner Walk/ Trot on a lead Showmanship	Walk, Trot. Lead by an attendant. Judged on rider & ring presence.
25	Country Pleasure Racking - Flat Shod	Walk, <b>Rack</b> . Back in line up.
26	Juvenile English Rider	Walk, Trot or Rack. English Tack.
27	Walkingbred - Padded or Flat Shod	Walk, <b>Rack</b> , Rack On.
28	Adult English Pleasure	Walk, Trot, Canter- English tack, any breed.
29	Show Pleasure Racking - Padded or Flat Shod	Walk, <b>Show Pleasure Rack</b> . Back in lineup.
30	Flat Shod Racking	Walk, <b>Rack</b> , Rack On. Any breed racking horse.
31	Adult Western Walk/Jog	Walk, Jog- Back in Lineup.
32	Adult Western Pleasure	Walk, Jog, Lope- Back in lineup.
33	Open Racking Championship- Padded or Flat Shod	Walk, <b>Rack</b> , Rack on.
34	Horsemanship- Pattern Class	Walk, Trot. Patterns will be posted when registration opens.

**Adult:** over 18 years old / **Juvenile:** under 17 years old / **Beginner:** any age, 4 years or less showing for the rider.

**Gate Fee:** \$5 12 and under free

**Regular Classes:** \$5.00/Members, \$10.00/Non-member per class      **Championship Classes:** \$10/ Members, \$15/ Non- member

**Double Dollar Bareback:** \$2.00 provided by rider to be used in event.

If you show in classes 5 & 6 you can not show in classes 10 & 11 and vice versa.

Classes with 5 or more juvenile riders and adult riders will be split. Classes will also be split by discipline if 5 or more of one discipline are present

**\*\*\*Negative Coggins - Required by Georgia Law\*\*\* Coggins will be checked**

Western or English Tack - Casual dress or show attire

Registration opens 2 hour prior to the start of the show.

Registration for the first 4 classes closes 20 minutes prior the start of the show.

### MIDWAY SADDLE CLUB GENERAL RULES

- 1 The judge's decision is final.
- 2 No juvenile's will be allowed to show a stallion in any class.
- 3 No boot, false tails, crops or full bridles (4 rein bridles) are allowed in any country pleasure or trail classes.
- 4 No boots, false tails or switches are allowed in show pleasure classes, however you may ride with a crop and full bridle (4 rein bridle) if desired.
- 5 No chains, leather rings, knocker boots or other action devices are allowed in any class. Bell boots and heel boots are allowed in performance classes.
- 6 To receive a refund, your horse must be scratched at least 2 classes prior to the class from which the horse is being removed.
- 7 No disorderly conduct allowed or tolerated, no alcohol, no animals except horses allowed.
- 8 The ringmaster has the authority to remove any horse from the arena deemed out of control.

**The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel any class. Midway Saddle Club will not be held responsible for any accident or injury.**
