Did you know that your mouth is one of the first things people notice about your face? Youthful, colorful, and plump lips make us look younger.



WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN LIP TATTOOS AND LIP FILLER?

Lip filler can give you volume and projection. Lip Blush cannot but it can certainly give the illusion of bigger, more pouty lips by defining a perfect shape.

Lip filler involves injecting a dermal filler, made of hyaluronic acid, into the lips to

- that add volume, shape, and definition
- thin lips
- ** restore lost volume
- smooth out wrinkles and lines around the mouth



On the other hand, **lip blush is a semi-permanent makeup** technique that involves tattooing the lips to create **a natural-looking, tinted effect.**

It can

- enhance the color, shape, and definition of the lips,
- giving them a more vibrant and youthful appearance.


The results of lip filler can last for several months before additional treatments may be needed. Lip blush lasts for around 2-3 years.



The rate at which the pigment and definition fade over time depends on your skin type, sun exposure, skincare routine, diet, and lifestyle habits.

Lip blushing treatments can be used to correct asymmetry in the lips and restore balance to the face.

By enhancing the natural shape and color of the lips, lip blushing can create a more symmetrical, balanced look that complements the rest of the face.



Lip fillers can also help to correct asymmetry in the lips, but lip blushing may be a better option for those looking for a more natural, subtle enhancement.


Lip filler provides immediate results and can be adjusted as desired, while lip blush offers a long-lasting solution without the need for frequent touch-ups.

A common concern with lip blushing or filler is whether they will hurt. And if so, how painful will these procedures be?


While the lips are a naturally sensitive area, both

of these treatments rate fairly low on the pain scale
thanks to the lidocaine used during the session
either in a numbing cream applied beforehand
or inside the injectable itself.

Wait at least 2 weeks after lip blushing to get any additional lip injections or fillers.

- Following these guidelines will
 ensure that there's enough time
 for your lips to recover
