PASSION - zeal - joy - courage - integrity - wisdom - love	thinking for themselves celebrating others' skills and talents. - understanding that it is their responsibility to stand up for what is right, including calling out racism and bullying. - taking part in fundraising activities for local, national and international charities to make moves towards equity for all. - being creative in their work and presentation, using their talents and strengths. - seeking out and enjoy challenging work thinking before they act – what are the consequences? being curious about other cultures, religions, traditions, ethnicities and stand up for what is right. using the rules to set their moral compass, ensuring that they and their peers are treated fairly and equally. - try new things
SUCCESS - humility - diligence - empowerment - connection - resilience - inclusion	understanding that families come in all shapes and sizes. tolerance towards others - making the right choices (sometimes in difficult situations) demonstrating their individual liberty - showing that they value our Rights and Responsibilities and recognise how this is linked to Rule of Law - taking part in school and/or class council discussions; understand that they have a 'voice' through democratic procedures - thinking and supporting of others - working well as part of a team - listening to the ideas and opinions of others - striving to excel in all that they do - demonstrating perseverance and an understanding that learning can take time. - are resilient when faced with challenge and/or failure - creating a positive and supportive learning environment
