Generosity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • take part in fundraising activities for local, national and international charities • share the things they have • support others
Patience	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • show tolerance towards others • demonstrate perseverance and an understanding that learning can take time • wait their turn in games or conversation
Pride	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • talk about what being part of Pattishall CE Primary School means to them • strive to present their work to the best of their ability • wear the correct uniform • look after the school environment, both indoors and out • talk about their achievements
