- Assess, record and report pupil progress according to school policy
- Promote and organise a range of curricular and extracurricular activities, for example, productions, assemblies, trips, speakers and after school clubs
- Manage pupil homework, according to school policy
- Liaise with school's SENDCo and PP Lead to prepare individual pupil support
- Build a positive and professional partnership with parents maintaining regular communication in line with our caring ethos
- Support and understand children's behaviour to ensure promotion of our school values and positive learning behaviour
- Promote and safeguard the welfare of pupils, maintaining a constant awareness of all issues relating to child protection
- Be involved in decision making and policy development across the school in consultation with whole staff, where appropriate
