Compassion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Thinking of others</li> <li><b>Thinking before they act</b> – <b>what are the consequences?</b></li> <li><b>Thinking for themselves</b></li> <li>take part in <b>fundraising activities</b> for local, national and international charities to <b>make moves towards equity for all</b>.</li> <li>care for school property</li> <li>share the things they have</li> <li>support others</li> <li>show <b>tolerance</b> towards others</li> <li>wait their turn in games or conversation</li> <li>work well as part of a team</li> <li>listen to the ideas and opinions of others</li> <li>create a positive and supportive learning environment</li> <li>take part in school and/or class council discussions; understand that they have a 'voice' through <b>democratic</b> procedures</li> <li><b>Understand that families come in all shapes and sizes.</b></li> </ul>
Joy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be creative and flexible in their thinking.</li> <li>Be creative in their work and presentation, using their talents and strengths.</li> <li>seek out and enjoy challenging work</li> <li><b>Celebrate others' skills and talents.</b></li> </ul>
Bravery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Be curious</b> about other cultures, religions, traditions, ethnicities and <b>stand up for what is right.</b></li> <li>make the right choices (sometimes in difficult situations) demonstrating their <b>individual liberty</b></li> <li>try new things</li> <li>are resilient when faced with challenge and/or failure</li> <li>show that they value our Rights and Responsibilities and recognise how this is linked to <b>Rule of Law</b></li> <li>Understand that it is their responsibility to stand up for what is right, <b>including calling out racism and bullying.</b></li> <li><b>Using the rules</b> to set their moral compass, ensuring that <b>they and their peers are treated fairly and equally.</b></li> </ul>
Determination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>demonstrate perseverance and an understanding that learning can take time.</li> <li>strive to excel in all that they do</li> <li>believe they will learn and improve with effort</li> <li>are open-minded and flexible to change</li> </ul>
