<u>Native Plants</u> – Interested in going native? Attracting pollinators and birds? Go to this site, enter your zip code, and have fun!

Now, where to buy plants? The big box stores are OK, but I like to shop at <u>Campbell Road</u> <u>Nursery</u>, <u>Fairview Garden Center</u> or the State Farmer's Market.

Guilty pleasure – going to the Open House at Plant Delights Nursery!

Maybe you just like to LOOK at gardens – then check out <u>Biltmore Virtual Tours</u>. The <u>Craven County Center</u> has a page with links to lots of virtual tours of museums, parks, and historical sites. And you can see the beautiful gardens of Wilmington <u>here</u>.


