

# Madison High School Alumni Association Scholarship Application

The MHSAA Scholarship awards non-renewable scholarships to graduating seniors. Recipients are selected on the basis of scholarship, leadership, and service to their community. The scholarship was established by Madison Alumni to recognize the efforts of deserving students and provide financial support for their pursuit of a higher education which includes 4-year college, Junior college (2-year), Community College or Trade School.

## **APPLICANTS MUST:**

1. Graduate by August 2026.
2. Have GPA of 2.0 or above.
3. Complete application form and essay.
4. Document community activities.
5. Confirm admission to a post-secondary certified program prior to August 2026.
6. Submit official digital copy of high school transcript to [Scholarships@madisonalumni.onmicrosoft.com](mailto:Scholarships@madisonalumni.onmicrosoft.com)
7. Provide 1 letter of recommendation (*can be from school representative, clergy, community and/or civic representative, or any non-relative who knows you well*).
8. Complete interview with scholarship panel.

## **IMPORTANT TIPS:**

Applications are reviewed and evaluated in various categories/ areas - on a weighted average (points awarded in each category). Failure to complete any portion of the application greatly reduces your chance of being awarded a scholarship. For example, failure to list community service will lower overall points – possibly enough to eliminate you from competition.

## **OTHER SUGGESTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- Make sure your cumulative grade point average appears on your transcripts.
- Make sure the entire application is filled out.
- Have someone proofread your application and essay for grammatical errors and clarity.
- Only send the materials requested - do not include copies of awards, certificates, etc.
- E-mail application before the deadline. Date on email when received is date of submission.
- Make sure everything is attached - don't e-mail items separately.

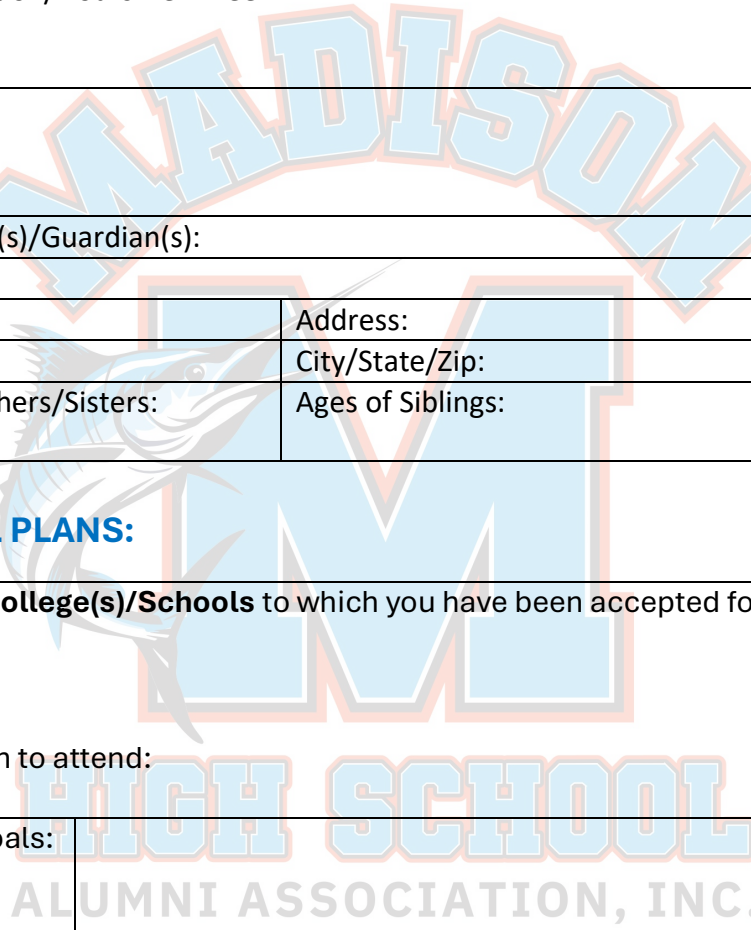
