ELIGIBILITY

- Graduating Senior from Birmingham area school
- Accepted to a 4-year, 2-year, or vocational school

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- One recipient will be selected from the following categories:
 - o (Ajha's Scholars)
 - Academic scholarship students with GPA of 3.5 or greater
 - (Pink Scholarship)
 - Needs based scholarship students with the greatest financial need
 - o (The CEO Scholarship) Creating Enrichment Opportunities
 - Leadership/Civic scholarship students that have been leaders in the school and/or community
 - o (Creative Excellence in Motion)
 - Arts Appreciation scholarship students with an interest in pursuing a major in the arts
- Students are required to submit a 1-page personal statement that includes the following:
 - o The category for which they are applying.
 - $_{\circ}$ A defining moment in their life and the lessons learned from that experience.
 - o A summary of their overall career goals.
