CITY HALL

City Hall is located at 301 E Main St. The City Clerks hours are M-F from 7:30 AM - 12:15 PM and from 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM. The phone number is 373-5218. GARBAGE COLLECTION

Garbage pickup is done curbside on Monday of each week.

RECYCLING

Anthon has an active recycling program to help with waste reduction in compliance with state standards. Recycling is picked up curbside on Tuesday, every other week. Cardboard boxes should be broken down so they are flat. If any items are not picked up, it means they are not acceptable for recycling and should be disposed of in your garbage. For more information on the recycling program please call the landfill at 712-873-3837. To purchase a Pink recycling container, call Gill Hauling @ 402- 404-3035 and ask for Natalie. Please use discretion when setting out your recyclables. If it's very windy, either anchor down your containers or wait until the next time. Please remember that all material must be clean and dry to be picked up. There are also recycling dumpsters located in the vacant lot east of the Post Office. These are available for Anthon residents to use.

UTILITIES

Electricity, Water and Sewer is provided by the city and is billed monthly. Included on your utility bill are charges for electricity, water, sewer, garbage, landfill, sales tax and water excise tax. The bills are due on the 5th of the month and can be paid by the 25th of the same month to avoid penalty and posting fees. Bills can be paid online or in person with a credit/debit card for a small fee. Monthly Auto pay can be set up at no additional charge for the 15th of each month using your checking account. You may opt to have your utility bill emailed monthly or choose the post card bill which comes via US mail.

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

Our city government is the Council-mayor type. Five council members and the Mayor are elected by the voters. Every two years there is an election due to the staggered terms of the members. We do not have precincts. The city council meets the second Monday of each month at 5:30 PM at city hall and you are welcome and urged to attend these meetings.

Weeds or other vegetation - You are required by city ordinance to keep all weeds and other vegetation mowed or under control.

Snow removal - City ordinance requires the clearing of snow and ice from sidewalks abutting your property 24 hours after cessation of a snowfall. No person shall park, abandon, or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or city off-street parking area during snow removal unless the snow has been removed or plowed from said street and snowfall has ceased

Building permits - Permits are required for building or re-modeling when you increase the size of the existing building (this includes decks). There is a \$10.00 charge for the permit and it can be obtained at city hall.

Dogs - Dog licenses are due in January each year. The annual fee is \$20.00 for a non neutered/ spayed dog and \$10.00 for each neutered/spayed dog. Owners shall not allow their animals to run at large within the city limits. Please contact City Hall with any questions regarding City Code for pets.

Courthouse - The Little Courthouse is a satellite office of the Woodbury County Courthouse in Sioux City and is located at 105 N 2nd Avenue. You can renew your vehicle license, get vehicle titles, pay your property taxes and get IDNR hunting and fishing license. It is located at 105 N Second Ave and the phone number is 373-5238. Hours are Mon - Fri from 8 AM - 12:45 PM and 1:30 PM - 4:30 PM.

US Post Office - The Post Office is located at 109 N 2nd Avenue and the phone number is 373-5301. Hours are Monday through Friday from 7:30 AM - 11 AM and 1 PM - 3:30 PM. Saturday hours are from 8 AM until 9 AM.

Anthon Community Center - The Community Center is located at 110 N 5th Ave. and is available for rent for parties, receptions and much more! Contact City Hall @ 373-5218 for details.

Anthon Shelter House - The Shelter House is located at 510 State St. and is available for rent for many occasions! Contact City Hall @ 373-5218 for details.

Anthon Electronic City Sign - Contact City Hall if you would like to have something put on the electronic City Sign. Cost is \$2 a day or \$10 for 7 days. No charge for non-profits, area Churches and Benefits & MVAO School.
