

# nab Summer Playing Rules

## T-BALL DIVISION

- Batters will get three swings pitched underhand by the umpire.
- If no contact is made, the batting tee will be used.
- Each team will bat through the order each inning.
- Games are limited to three innings (if time allows).

## MINOR DIVISION

- Batter will get three swings pitched underhand by the umpire.
- If no contact is made, the batting tee will be used.
- The inning is over if three defensive outs are made or once through the batting order.

## MINOR DIVISION

- Batter will get three swings pitched overhand.
- If no contact is made on the third swing, the batter is out.
- No tee will be used.
- The inning is over if three defensive outs are made, or once through the batting order.

## MAJOR DIVISION

- Pitching — players pitch with the umpire calling balls and strikes from behind the pitcher. There are no walks after ball four. The umpire will assume the number of strikes and pitch to the batter.
- On a strike three swing and miss, or called strike three, the batter is out.
- If hit by a pitch by a “player” pitcher, it counts as a ball.
- NO PLAYER CAN PITCH MORE THAN TWO INNINGS PER WEEK (ONE INNING PER GAME OR TWO INNINGS IN ONE GAME).
- No player can play the same defensive position more than TWO innings per game.
- No player can sit more than one inning until everyone has sat out an inning.
- No more than 11 players on the field per inning (e.g., P, C, 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, short-center, and four OF).
- The inning is over once the defensive team has recorded three outs, or batted once through the batting order.
