

Museum Pass Policy

Borrowing Limits and Rules

Passes are available to adults with a valid Hellertown Area Library card and who also reside in the Saucon Valley School District.

Patrons may borrow 1 museum pass per family.

All museum passes have a loan period of one week and are not available for renewal.

Borrowers should have their library card to present at the museum upon entering.

Borrowers are responsible for calling or visiting the museum's website for the most up-to-date information on hours of operation, directions and parking.

The museum determines the rules and regulations governing the use of its museum passes.

The library assumes no responsibility of any kind arising out of the use of museum passes.

What Happens if I Lose a Pass or Return It Late?

Late passes incur a \$10.00/day fine.

Maximum fine limit: Is the cost of the Museum Pass to the library.

Lost passes are assessed at the replacement rate determined by the library. This replacement rate is listed in our online catalog and on the pass package. Passes are considered lost after 30 days.

Reserve A Pass

Place a hold on a museum pass just like any other item in our collection by using our online catalog or calling the library.

Return A Pass

Passes *must* be returned directly to our Circulation Desk during regular business hours. Museum Passes may not be placed in the book drop.
