Post-Accident Testing Rates and Information

- Post-Accident-Keys Consortium office during working hours \$65
- Post-Accident-Keys Consortium office after working hours \$100
- Post-Accident-Keys Consortium office weekends and holidays \$150
- Post-Accident-Employers/Accident Location (Mobile) during working hours \$150 plus mileage
- Post-Accident-Employers/Accident Location (Mobile) after hours - \$200 plus mileage

Alcohol Testing - All locations should be set up to conduct alcohol testing immediately after any incident. Alcohol testing should occur immediately from 0-2 hours, but no attempt should be made to test for alcohol after 8 hours. If alcohol testing does not occur within 2 hours an explanation as to why should be included with the report. (We recommend that every employer keeps saliva alcohol testing devices on site to avoid missing the two hour window for after hours post-accident testing)

Drug Testing – Post incident drug testing should occur within 32 hours of the incident.

Premium charges can be avoided in the employer conducts their own alcohol saliva test and sends the employee to drug test the next day as long as the test falls within the 32 hour window.
