The following questions are designed to clarify your project's requirements. While we're here to guide you, it's ideal if you can answer about 75% of them before requesting a quote. This preparation will streamline our discussions and lead to a more precise proposal.

Do you need fabrication of an exiting design?

(For webform) Brief description of item to be fabricated.

DESIGN SPECIFICATIONS

- Do you have a complete design, including technical drawings and dimensions? (If not, see next column. →)
- What are the dimensions and tolerances?
- What, if any, materials are required or preferred?

FUNCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- What is your desired outcome(s)?
- What is your WHY? What problem is being solved or value to be added?
- What are the key functional requirements?
- Finish/coating requirements (e.g., powder coating, paint)?

LOCATION OF FABRICATION

- Does this project need to be done at your location, or can we do it in our workshop?

CONSTRAINTS AND CONSIDERATIONS

- Size, weight, or space limitations?
- Any industry standards to meet?
- Any site or material challenges (e.g., access to the site, unusual material requests)?

TIMELINE AND BUDGET

- Target budget?
- Preferred completion timeline?

PROJECT PRIORITIES AND SUCCESS CRITERIA

- Is appearance important or just functionality?
- How will you measure success?
- What is most important: cost, speed, or quality? Pick two.
