DAMAGE ASSESSMENT & REPAIR NEEDS

- What type of damage or wear does the item have?
- What material is the item made from (e.g., steel, aluminum, stainless steel)?
- What is the approximate age and condition of the item?
 Have any previous repairs been done on the item? If so, what were they?
- Is the item still functional, or does it require immediate attention?
- Is a finish or coating required after repair?

LOCATION OF REPAIR

Does the repair need to be done at your location or can you bring it to us?

CONSTRAINTS & CONSIDERATIONS

- Size, weight, or space limitations?
- Any industry standards to meet?
- Any site or material challenges (e.g., access to the site, unusual material requests)?

TIMELINE AND BUDGET

- Target budget?
- Preferred completion timeline?

PROJECT PRIORITIES AND SUCCESS CRITERIA

- Is appearance important or just functionality?
- How will you measure success?
- What is most important: cost, speed, or quality? Pick two.
