Fun Fact: This name gives nod to the excellent health and top winning BRT pedigrees behind our dogs including the first Best In Show BRT in the United States.



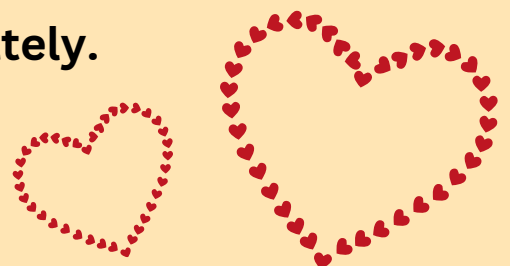
WORD OF CAUTION

Please keep these toxic, tasty treats away from your dogs in an unreachable location. Common foods enjoyed around Valentine's day that are toxic to dogs include but are not limited to:

1. **Chocolate** - the darker the more toxic
2. **Some artificial sweeteners** such as Xylitol (also known as birch sugar, birch bark sugar) often found in gum and candy.
3. **Nuts**
4. **Raisins**
5. **Alcohol**
