1. The Services

- A. Epona Riding Academy will provide the client with ___ (1, 2, or 3) 45-minute group riding lesson(s) or 30-minute private lesson(s) per week, along with 15-30 minutes of grooming/horsemanship instruction.
- B. Grooming/horsemanship is an additional educational opportunity provided at no extra cost, offered when it best fits the schedule
- C. Epona Riding Academy will provide the lesson horse, saddle, bridle, and necessary horse equipment. Riders are expected to obtain their own helmet and boots after their first full month with Epona.
 - D. Riders will be grouped with others of similar ability to foster camaraderie and improve learning. Private lessons are available for beginners or riders unable to join a group.
 - E. New riders will start with a 30-minute private lunge-line lesson until capable of joining a group lesson.

2. Client Requirements

- A. Clients must arrive on time.
- B. Riders must wear proper attire: boots with heels and long pants. Helmets are mandatory for all lessons. Riders may bring their own ASTM/SEI-certified helmet or use one provided by Epona.
- C. Clients must maintain a positive and coachable attitude. Failure to follow safety guidelines may result in removal from the program without refund.
- D. Parents/guardians may not coach or involve themselves with horses unless they are the designated participant.
- E. Guests, outside pets, and unsupervised children are not permitted unless authorized by an instructor.

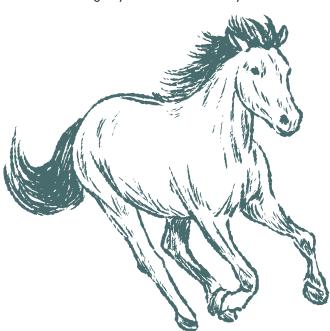


WHAT TO BRING

- Helmet (ASTM/SEI-certified, required for all riders)
- Boots (closed-toe with a heel for safety)
- Comfortable riding attire (jeans, breeches, or leggings; no shorts or sandals)
- Water bottle (stay hydrated!)
- Gloves (optional, for grip and hand protection)

WEATHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Training will continue in most weather conditions unless extreme heat, rain, or wind creates unsafe conditions.
- Clients should dress appropriately and bring layers for cooler days

- Instructor Authority Only Epona Riding instructors provide coaching; outside coaching is not permitted.
- Appropriate Attire Clients must wear proper riding attire, including helmets and boots.
- 4. Respect for Horses Horses must be treated with care and patience; mistreatment will not be tolerated.
- 5. **Booking & Cancellation** Sessions must be booked in advance. Cancellations require at least 24 hours' notice.
- 6. Groundwork Matters Riding is a privilege and is based on demonstrated respect for horses and proper horsemanship skills.
- Barn Etiquette Keep noise levels low, follow safety procedures, and clean up after yourself.
- Liability Waiver All clients must sign an Epona and Sandbar Sanctuary liability waiver before participating in any training sessions.
- 9. Guest Policy We love that you want to share our magical world with friends and family, but please check with Instructors prior to bringing guests on to the grounds.

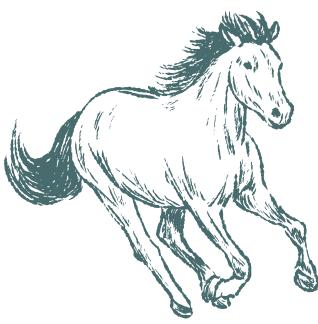
