


CHARACTERISATION:

OPINION:

Do you think it is okay for Milton to cry? Why or why not?

Why do you think Milton and Wanda use their real names with each other instead of their nicknames?

EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:

ART	Draw a new scene that shows Milton feeling an emotion. How does he react to his feelings? Ask students how they would react in that situation.	
MUSIC	What kind of songs do you like to listen to? How do certain songs make you feel? Listen to a few different songs and have your class describe how it makes them feel. Examples: Justin Timberlake "I've Got a Feeling" Taylor Swift "Shake It Off" Tori Kelly "Hallelujah" from "Sing" Original Soundtrack Imagine Dragons "Believer"	
VIDEO	Watch this video with your class and have them guess the different emotions. Then have them make facial expressions for each other and guess. Answers: happy, annoyed, sad, scared/startled, proud, excited, angry, shy, nervous, disgusted	
SNACK	Milton and Wanda LOVE ice cream! It's their favorite treat. Ice cream might be a tricky snack for school so fill ice cream cones with M&Ms, goldfish crackers, or Cheerios! Bonus points for "cheer"ios or "tear"ios!	

ART ACTIVITY: Let's create a new scene in the story that would be another reason Milton or Wanda might cry. Is it because they are happy? Sad? Scared? Nervous? Or feeling another emotion? Use the space below to draw the scene.
