Women's Swimming– Megan Lasto (ECSU)



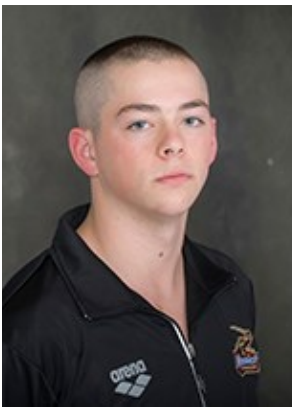
WILLIMANTIC, CT– **Megan Lasto**, Freshman at ECSU, has been voted as the Swimmer of the Week for the second week in a row.

At the Louise Goodrum Invitational this past weekend In the non-scoring meet versus 7 other colleges and universities; Megan Lasto claimed firsts in the 50 (28.84), 100 butterfly (1:03.79) and 100 individual medley (1:06.93). She also swam the anchor on the 200 medley relay (free 25.43) which finished first. She was also second in the 100 breaststroke and fourth in the 50 breaststroke.

Prior to her swimming career at Eastern, Lasto swam for Amity Regional High School in Orange, CT. She is majoring in Visual Arts.

Megan and the ECSU Warriors return to the pool on Friday November 10th vs. Western CT State.
