Women's Swimming– Sarah Leonard (Regis College)



WESTON, MA– **Sarah Leonard**, a Junior at **Regis**, has been voted as the NEISDA Swimmer of the Week for the second week of the season.

Sarah won both the 50 back (28.95) and 100 free (57.62), and was an important piece in helping lead the Pride to their first victory over UNE in team history.

KEENE, NH– **Jessica Masotta**, a Junior at **Keene State**, has been voted as the NEISDA Diver of the Week for the second week of the season.

Jessica won both the 1 meter (175.30) & 3 meter (179.50) diving events. She was able to hold off her fellow teammate Brianna Feldman by 12.1 points in the 1 meter, and by 46.05 points in the 3 meter.
