Women's Swimming– Ellie Field (RWU)



WESTON, MA– **Ellie Field**, a Freshman at **Roger Williams**, has been voted as the NEISDA Swimmer of the Week for the seventh week of the season.

Ellie recorded 5 first place finishes vs. BSU & Wheaton. On Wednesday night, Ellie anchored the winning 400 Medley Relay, while also taking first in the 50 Free & 100 Free. On Friday versus Wheaton, she anchored the third place Medley Relay (24.4). Ellie would go on to win the 50 Free (25.07) & 100 Free (54.58), and concluded with anchoring the 2nd place 200 Free Relay (24.8).

Prior to her swimming career at RWU, Ellie swam for Hoosac Valley High School in Cheshire, MA. She is majoring in Public Health at RWU.

Ellie and the RWU Hawks return to the pool on November 30th at WPI for the Gompeii Invitational.

In the meet against Bridgewater State, he swam the 1000 Free (10:31.01), 500 Free (5:01.36), 400 Free Relay (50.2), and against Wheaton he swam the 200 Free (1:47.57), and 500 Free (4:58.41)
