Women's Swimming- Molly Henry (WCSU)



WESTON, MA- Molly Henry, a Freshman at WCSU, has been voted as the NEISDA Swimmer of the Week for the ninth week of the season.

Molly helped lead the Colonials to a victory over FDU Florham on Saturday, January 5. She placed 1st in both the 50 free (26.93) and the 100 back (1:09.35). Molly also was the anchor on the winning 200 Free Relay.

Prior to her swimming career at WCSU, Molly comes from Pound Ridge, NY and swam for Fox Hill High School in Bedford, NY.

Molly and the WCSU Colonials return to the pool on January 16th at Maine Maritime Academy.

## Men's Swimming-GianCarlos Banrey (Regis College)



WESTON, MA- GianCarlos Banrey, a Freshman at Regis College, has been voted as the NEISDA Swimmer of the Week for the ninth week of the season.

GC posted the best finish among all Pride swimmers at the FIU Sprint Invitational, finishing second in the 50 butterfly. In the tournament-style event, he opened with a second-place finish in 23.81 seconds, followed by a third-place finish in the quarterfinal in 24.14 seconds. He advanced to the final thanks to a semifinal time of 23.62 seconds but lost in the head-to-head final to Lukas Wormald of the University of Waterloo (23.44 to 23.75 seconds).

Prior to his swimming career at Regis, Banrey swam for Boston Latin High School in Boston, MA. He is majoring in History at Regis.
