## SWIMMERS OF THE WEEK

### Women's Swimming – Erin Madden, Husson University

**Erin Madden**, a First Year student at **Husson University**, has been voted as the NEISDA Women's Swimmer of the Week.



Erin had a busy day in the pool, helping Husson to a 180-88 win over Maine Maritime with three individual podium finishes and a first-place relay effort. She won the 100-yard Breast (1:18.03), the 200-yard Breast (2:47.18) and the 200-yard IM (2:28.77). She was also part of the winning 200-yard Freestyle Relay, splitting a 27.75.

She is from Stratham, N.H. Husson will next be travelling to Eastern Ct State for a dual meet on November 6.

### Men's Swimming – Nathan Gilliam, Husson University

**Nathan Gilliam**, a First Year student at **Husson University**, has been voted as the NEISDA Men's Swimmer of the Week.



Against Maine Maritime, Gilliam started his afternoon off with a victory in the 1000 Freestyle with a new school record time of 11:00.72. He then followed that up with another victory in the 500 Freestyle in another school record time of 5:18.35. He also won the 200 IM with a time of 2:14.71, and wrapped up the meet swimming the third leg of the 200 Freestyle Eagle "B" Relay with a 26.19 split to help the Eagles earn their first win over the Mariners since the 2018-19 season.

He is from Wiscasset, Maine. Husson will next be travelling to Eastern Ct State for a dual meet on November 6.
