SWIMMERS OF THE WEEK

Women's Swimming – Noelle Schneider, Roger Williams University



Noelle Schneider, a Freshman at **Roger Williams University**, has been voted as the NEISDA Women's Swimmer of the Week.

Noelle had an outstanding weekend at the URI Harold Anderson Invitational breaking two school records and scoring 19 points. She took second place in the Women's 100 Fly with a new school record and conference leading time of 56.92. She lead off the Women's 200 Free Relay with a time of 25.07 and helped that relay to a new team record. Noelle also finished 15th in the Women's 200 Fly with a 2:13.35. In the Women's 200 Medley Relay she split a 25.61 Butterfly and in the 400 Medley Relay she split a 58.13. Above her swimming performances according to Head Coach Matt Emmert, "Noelle was a constant source of inspiration & cheering for her teammates throughout the duration of the meet."

Noelle is from Plymouth, MA., and is majoring in Computer Science. The Hawks will next travel to New London, CT to take on Connecticut College on Dec. 11 at 1pm.

Men's Swimming – Riley Williams, Roger Williams University



Riley Williams, a Sophomore at **Roger Williams University**, has been voted as the NEISDA Men's Swimmer of the Week.

Riley had a breakthrough performance at last weekend's URI Harold Anderson Invitational breaking 1 school record and scoring 44 points. He placed 4th in the 200 IM with a 1:52.99; 3rd in the 400 IM with a NCAA "B" qualifying time and a new school record time of 4:01.49; and 5th in the 200 Breast with a 2:05.58. Riley was a part of the 200 Medley Relay which finished 4th, splitting a 25.97 Breaststroke leg; the 400 Medley Relay splitting a 56.93 Breaststroke; the 800 Free Relay splitting a 1:45.65; and the 400 Free Relay splitting a 47.73. Riley helped the Hawks to overcome Division I teams Holy Cross the University of Maine.

Riley is from Arvada, CO. The Hawks will next travel to New London, CT to take on Connecticut College on Dec. 11 at 1pm.

Founded in 1920, the New England Intercollegiate Swimming and Diving Association (NEISDA) is a coach-run association made up member institutions in New England.

NEISDA annually sponsors and administers a championship for those qualifying swimmers and divers in February.
