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### Checklist - 2019 Tax Return

GENERAL INFORMATION & INCOME: 1. Copy of last year's Fed & State Tax Returns ( <u>New Clients Only</u> )
2. Copy of Drivers License/State Issued ID or you may write down your Driver's License number, date issued, and expiration date. (New Clients Only or if you did not submit last year).
3. Taxpayers and Dependent's Social Security Numbers, Full Names (as they appear on Soc.Sec. Card), and Birthdates. (New Clients or for a New Dependent)
4. All Income Statements: W-2's, 1099's, Social Security, Unemployment, Retirement (1099-R)
5. Records of Other Income and Expense: Sale of Property (Escrow papers-Final Closing Statement/HUD-1 and list of improvements), Rental Income & Expenses, Investment Interest, Dividend Income, Sale of Stocks, Farm Income.
DEDUCTIONS:  6. <b>Medical Costs:</b> Total Out-of-Pocket expenses paid for doctor, dentists, eye glasses & exams, lab fees, monthly premiums, prescriptions and travel (mileage). (Must total over 7.5% of gross income to be deductible)
7. Property Tax Statements, Sales Tax (large items), DMV fees, Car Purchase Contracts.
8. Interest Paid: Mortgage Statement (Form 1098). Escrow Papers (Final Closing Stmt-HUD 1) for purchase, sale or refinance of properties.
9. <b>List of Contributions:</b> to Charities and Religious Organizations. (by Cash/Check & Non Cash-Thrift Store Value of Items)
10. Employment Expenses (For Self Employed Tax Payers and State Tax Filers only — as of 2018, W2 wage earners can no longer take a deduction for employment expenses on the federal tax return): Safety Equip. (shoes, gloves, etc.), Uniforms & Protective Clothing, Laundering of Uniforms, Tools & Supplies, Travel, Auto Expenses (business mileage), Cell Phone, Etc. all totaled in categories.
OTHER - MISCELLANEOUS: 11. Child Care Expenses: \$ Amt paid. Name. Address. Phone. Social Sec.# or Tax ID# of provider.

\_\_\_\_\_12. College Tuition (Taxpayers and Dependents): \$ Amount paid for Tuition (Form 1098-T) and Year of College (i.e., freshman, sophmore, etc.), \$ amount for books/supplies/computers, if required for course.

\_\_\_\_\_13. Health Insurance — As of tax year 2019, there is no longer a penalty fee for not having health insurance. However, if you have health insurance through Covered CA or The Exchange, you must provide the 1095-A form on your tax return.

\_\_\_\_\_14. Losses Sustained: Accidents, Fire, Theft, etc. (Out of Pocket Expense must total over 10% of gross income to be deductible.)

\_\_\_\_\_15. Credits: Plug in vehicles (new vehicles only-bring contract) and Solar Panels (purchased only, not leased, please bring your purchase contract)

\_\_\_\_\_16. Automatic Deposit of Refund — Bank Name, Account #, Routing Number and Type of Account (i.e. checking or savings, include a cancelled check, if possible.)

# <u>CUT OFF DATE</u> FOR MAIL-IN & DROP-OFF RETURNS IS <u>MARCH 25th, 2020</u> TO GUARANTEE COMPLETION BY the APRIL 15<sup>th</sup>, Tax Deadline!

**Electronic Filing (e-file).** Your refund will be deposited into your account or a check will be mailed to you within **approximately** 14 business days of submission...No additional fee charged for e-file.

**Fees:** State & Federal Income Tax Prep. Long forms **starting at** \$140, EZ Forms **starting at** \$60, Short Forms 1040A/540A **starting at** \$70, and Corporate Returns and LLC's **starting at** \$200.

Long Forms include Federal and/ or State filing with Itemized Deductions (Sch. A), & Interest Income (Sch. B). There may be additional fees for additional forms such as: Education Credit, EIC and Child Care Credit Business Income & Expense (Sch. C), Rental Income (Sch. E), Depreciation, and Sale of Property or Stocks (Sch. D), etc.

#### Additional fees for copies, mailing & downloading.

- 1) Copies \$5 for each year requested
- 2) Mail Out Returns \$5 shipping & handling flat fee for all paperwork mailed by regular USPS mail and Actual Charges for USPS Priority Mail, UPS Ground and Fed X mailings NOTE: Returns completed and mailed out to clients will not be electronically filed until the signed E-File Authorization and Payment is received.
- 3) Downloading multiple pages and documents \$10+ (we will notify you for approval before downloading)

Payment — made at final pick-up of paperwork or at appointment by CASH, CHECK, OR CREDIT CARD/DEBIT CARD (\$1 additional fee for Credit & Debit Cards). We ACCEPT Visa, Mastercard & Discover cards ONLY.

Saturday: 9:00am to 5:00pm Sunday: 10:00am to 5:00pm

If you file an Extension: Corporate Returns & LLC's — September 15<sup>th</sup>

Personal Income Tax Returns — October 15th

(You now have an automatic 6 month extension if you do not owe any taxes!)
