What do the scripture tell us of the one who is called Christ?

1. Conceived of Holy Spirit: Matthew 1:18-20
 2. Born of a Virgin: Matthew 1:23
 3. Grew up as Human: Luke 2:52
 4. Lived a Sinless Life: I Peter 2:22
 5. He gave Himself a Sacrifice for Our Sins: Philippians 2:8
 6. He Raised from Death and Ascended to The Father’s Right Hand: Philippians 2:9-11
 - a. Exalting Him Highly
 - b. Given a Name above All Names
 - c. That Every Knee shall bow Before Him
 - d. All Shall Confess Him as Christ to God’s Glory
- I. King Over His Kingdom
- a. Daniel 7:13-14
 - b. Promised to David: 2 Samuel 7:13-14
 - c. Spoken of by Jesus: Mark 9:1
 - d. Spoken of as Fulfilled: Acts 2:33-35, 8:12, Col. 1:13-14 & Rev. 1:9
 - e. Church & Kingdom are the Same: Matt. 16:18-19 & Luke 22:29-30
 - f. Must Be Born Again to See: John 3:3-5
 - g. When Christ Returns He Will Give Kingdom to The Father: 1 Cor. 15:23-27
- II. Jesus Is Lord
- a. Confessed As Lord: Romans 10:9
 - b. Term “Lord” (Kurios) was used in reference to Authority of Many Kinds: 1 Cor. 8:5
 1. Matthew 11:25 (The Father)
 2. Matthew 9:38 (Of Harvest)
 3. Acts 17:24 (God)
 4. Rev. 4:11 (God)
 - c. Used By Disciples for Christ (John 13:13-14)
 - d. Christ Taught with Authority (Matthew 7:29)
 - e. People Called Him Lord (Luke 6:46)
 - f. Lord in Judgment (Matthew 7:21-23)

- III. The Demanding Lord
- a. The Only One to Give Life: John 6:59-69 & 14:6
 - b. Take Up One's Cross: Matthew 16:24
 - c. Deny One's Self: Matthew 16:24
 - d. Lose One's Life: Matthew 16:25
 - e. Hate One's Parents and Family: Luke 14:25-26

Conclusion: Jesus' demands are not arbitrary, He expects His followers to observe "all things" given as doctrine to Christianity.

Matthew 28:20

Mat 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

Mat 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

Mat 28:20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you *always, even* unto the end of the world. Amen. " (KJV)
